| 211454 / 213613 | <p>A product attribute rule with any criteria was not working. Some picklist fields such as Approval Status, Billing Frequency, and Adjustment Type displayed none while remaining fields displayed all values.</p> <p>This issue is now resolved. The rule works correctly when the following condition is met:</p> <pre>*Condition expression* - AND(TEXT(\$. Apttus_Config2__LineStatus__c) == 'New',\$. Apttus_Config2__AttributeValueId__r. Apttus_Config2__Color__c=='Red',\$. Apttus_Config2__Quantity__c>1)</pre> | CPQ-14092 / 13824 |
| 212350 | <p>The option products nested in sub-bundle were not autoincluded when same option products were shared across different sub-bundles, although repeat inclusion constraint rule was set.</p> <p>This issue is now resolved. The constraint rule works correctly.</p> <p>For more information, see the Working with Constraint Rules topic in the Admin Guide.</p> | CPQ-13078 |

| 212348 | <p>When you set the 'Custom label Name' for 'Action Label Name' in the display action settings, then Custom label Name was displayed on the cart page instead of 'Custom label value'.</p> <p>The same issue was observed for translation when the custom Action Label Name on the cart was not getting translated.</p> <p>This issue is now resolved. A custom label value instead of custom label name is displayed on the cart.</p> | CPQ-13084 / 13911 |
| 213503 | <p>Client Side Constraint Rule (CSCR) did not display an alert message upon the validation error.</p> <p>This issue is now resolved. Validation constraint rule on bundle and standalone products with criteria on line item quantity field works properly and shows the alert message upon the validation error.</p> | CPQ-13656 / 12282 |
| 214088 | <p>Changing the Expiration Date on an Incentive record did not change the Expiration Date in the associated Price Rule. This caused incorrect pricing for the Incentive record.</p> <p>This issue is now resolved. The change in the Expiration Date changes the value in the Price Ruleset and Price Rule.</p> | CPQ-13937 |

Known Issues

The following table represents known issues on the release dated: August 9, 2017.

| ASSETS-784 / ASSETS-772 | When you Change or Renew a bundle product, the options are not shown under the correct option group. This behavior is observed when option groups are shared across multiple option groups. |
| ASSETS-938 | The Delta Price and Delta Quantity for an amended asset are incorrect. Delta Price and Delta Quantity are not supported in the previous and current release. |
| ASSETS-1016 | When performing a Swap operation on assets with one-time charge type, the Start Date of the upgraded asset is taken from the Proposal Start Date rather than the Swap Effective Date . To avoid this, you can choose to keep the Start and End Dates on the proposal <i>blank</i> and then swap the assets. |
| ASSETS-1173 | Cancelling Ramp lines and accepting Order displays positive delta pricing; whereas it should be negative. |
| ASSETS-1217 | Deselection of an option with a roll up (no bundle level Price List Item for the corresponding charge type) does not cancel the underlying roll up asset. |
| ASSETS-1226 | The warning message <i>Carousel Default Icon"!Error: No content domain found. Cannot display icon images</i> hinders the completion of Terminate and Renew actions. You must provide a value for the Carousel Default Icon (Config Settings > Catalog Page Settings) for most ABO actions to work. |
| ASSETS-1276 | Ramp Renew single line fetches the default attribute values along with other stored values on re-configuring renewal quote. |

| ASSETS-1283 | Cancelled recurring lines show both net price and delta price as negative. |
| ASSETS-1298 | Cancellation of the asset does not update the pre-generated renewal quote or cart associated with the asset. Swapping of the asset does not update the pre-generated renewal quote or cart associated with the asset. |
| ASSETS-1319 | Cancelling an asset with the cancellation date as start date calculates an incorrect net price. |
| ASSETS-1321 | The Default Asset Pricing Indicator is unchecked. When you have assets with attributes and asset pricing with some criteria, the Is Asset Pricing is checked. It should be unchecked. |
| ASSETS-1323 | Ramp cancellation is not working for Option assets. When a user tries to delete one of the ramps on a ramp option (using the trash icon on the ramp pop up), no cancelled line is generated and no delta price is computed. |
| ASSETS-1440 | For auto ramp creation with monthly frequency, the ramp line for the last month is not created. |
| ASSETS-1441 | For auto ramp creation with a custom frequency, all the ramp lines were created with the same Start and End Dates. |
| CPQ-5840 | When you unlock the default quantity for a Product Option, Apttus CPQ continues to use the default quantity value derived from the numeric expression which you defined. This, in turn, affects the Product Quantity and the Price. |
| CPQ-6562 | In the community org for classic UI, the system does not show values for the Search Filters on the catalog page. Under Refine Your Search section, you can see all the search filters without their values to select. |

| CPQ-6586 | <p>When you specify "Date Time" value for the product attribute and click Go To Pricing, the system shows the following error on the Cart page:</p> <p><i>!Unexpected type for Apttus_Config2.RemoteCPQController.performAction(Apttus_Config2.RemoteCPQ.CartRequestDO).</i></p> <p>Note: "Date time" attribute type is not supported in this release.</p> |
| CPQ-7187 | <p>The Constraint Rule triggered while deleting a Line Item displays the validation message twice on the Catalog and Cart pages. This behavior is observed when the validation message is triggered from an addError method in the trigger for Line Item object.</p> |
| CPQ-8674 | <p>When you apply adjustments to the Line Items in the Summary section and do not click Reprice on the Cart, the system allows you to finalize the Cart without giving any error.</p> |
| CPQ-9433 | <p>If the character limit for the name of the Quote/Proposal document generated using Proposal Document Generation exceeds 80, the system throws an error while merging this document with other additional documents.</p> |
| CPQ-10044 | <p>For a sub-bundle product, when Show Tab is set to <i>False</i> and option group has Is Picklist set to <i>True</i>, the Product Options tab displays the product attributes on the configuration page.</p> |
| CPQ-10286 | <p>If you have added <i>Apttus_Config2__Version__c</i> field in the Config System Properties > Revalidation Product Columns, the system throws a <i>"duplicate error"</i> on the revalidation pop-up on the cart page.</p> |
| CPQ-10518 | <p>While creating a Price Ruleset, Application Method field is enabled by default, irrespective of value in the Application Level field.</p> |

| CPQ-10659 | When you upgrade to this release, intermittently you may get the following error message: <i>Field \$Label.Choose does not exist. Check spelling. RemoteCPQ: Field \$Label.Choose does not exist. Check spelling.</i> |
| CPQ-10670 | PAV extension attribute fields, which are marked as primary attributes, do not get merged from the child to parent cart in the quote collaboration process. |
| CPQ-11866 | The enhanced smart search displays filter values in the slider, which are applicable for inactive products also. Ideally, the system must not consider the inactive products. |
| CPQ-12011 | With Related Price Scope set as <i>Cart</i> , for a scenario where the price of bundle A is related to the price of bundle B, after removing bundle B, the price of bundle A does not revert to the original price. |
| CPQ-12074 | Currently for Application Management Settings in the Admin Console, there is no provision to read all the flow related actions or columns in one setting group. As an admin, you have to create one setting group for each flow. |
| CPQ-12287 | For Application Management Settings in the Admin Console, when you create a new flow in Salesforce, the new flow record neither clones custom actions and columns nor creates a new setting group record. |

| CPQ-12377 | <p>New Admin Console: Unable to modify sub-categories in order to delete or re-arrange categories.</p> |
| CPQ-12418 | <p>For Proposal Document Generation, deleting a Proposal Document from the Proposals tab doesn't remove the document from Documents to be Merged section. You must refresh your browser tab to remove the document.</p> |
| CPQ-12476 | <p>For Proposal Document Generation inSF1mobile app, the drag and drop functionality for merging and uploading documents from local storage or salesforce is not available.</p> |
| CPQ-12504 | <p>In the new Admin Console, the Lookup Field tab available at CPQ Admin > Application Management > Developer tab is not functional with the current release.</p> |
| CPQ-12647 | <p>Getting numeric expression related errors on configuring a product and its values are also not getting set on picklist or multi picklist. When you use an empty string to reset the value, it works fine if set to null.</p> |
| CPQ-12662 | <p>The Option lines on the right panel of the Cart are not visible when a bundle has almost 10 price ramp lines.</p> |

| CPQ-12769 | New Admin Console: The Show Rules for Options check box does not read the nested bundle rules. |
| CPQ-12771 | New Admin Console: The Show Rules for Options check box does not bring Options Rules (PAR and AVM) when Options Rules are related to Options Product Group or Family. |
| CPQ-12787 | For Application Management Settings in the Admin Console, in a new org, clicking Load Defaults does not create setting group records for different settings existing in the system. |
| CPQ-12990 | When a product is removed manually, the auto-inclusion rule prompts up and adds the product to cart instead of giving an error message. |
| CPQ-13158 | Nested option product is not getting disabled based on the nested bundle and the option product selection. |
| CPQ-13216 | Bundle to Sub bundle auto inclusion based on the attribute criteria adds action but does not display info message. |
| CPQ-13218 | Action product gets added every time when bundle products associated to product group are configured, in spite of the fact that condition product have scope set to Product group - Include any. |
