Disable Asset Integration and Order Activation Enhancements

If you have enabled **Disable Asset Integration** checkbox for a Price List Item, an error appears when you activate an order. This error appears as there was no corresponding valid asset line item. Once you install Apttus Billing Management version 4.97 installed or later, order activation continues as billing now ignores any line without an asset id. You cannot see bills created for those orders because there is no asset.

Renewal Opportunity Enhancements with Enable One Time Change custom setting

In the Installed Product Settings page, when you deselect the **Enable One Time Change** checkbox and modify the asset, the renewal quote is updated for the modified asset. If **Enable One Time Change** is *false*, Renewal Opportunity and Renewal Quote is not created for the one-time only products, but if you modify the asset, the change is reflected in the Renewal Quote. If **Enable One Time Change** is *true*, Renewal Opportunity and Renewal Quote is not created for one time.

Hiding empty Option Groups with Hide Disabled Options custom setting

Hiding functionality for Option Groups has been enhanced in conjunction with the **Hide Disabled Options** custom setting.

With **Hide Disabled Options** set to *true* in **Config Settings > Bundle Page Settings**, an option group is hidden for the following scenarios:

- If the option group contains options which are auto-excluded by a constraint rule.
- If the option group has sub option groups which are hidden.

	<p>When the primary line of a product is <i>One time</i> and the Renewal Group field is blank, the system created two separate renewal opportunities for each asset although the corresponding recurring line had the same term.</p> <p>This issue is now resolved. The system creates a single renewal opportunity for an asset.</p>	ASSETS-1299
208466	<p>For product A with related pricing, when you applied a group adjustment to one or more line items whose price was related to the price of product A, the pricing of the related line items was calculated incorrectly. This behavior was observed for when the related products had different Charge Types.</p> <p>This issue is now resolved. Applying group adjustments for products with related pricing calculates the correct price for the scenario mentioned above.</p>	CPQ-11402
209071	<p>While importing a favorite configuration of a product which contains the same attribute at the bundle and option level, the system did not allow you to proceed on the catalog page.</p> <p>This issue is now resolved. When you clone a bundle with options which contain attributes and import these bundles as Favorites, the system imports the Favorites correctly.</p>	CPQ-11743

209133	<p>For a product with primary and secondary charge types, if the price of the secondary charge type is related to that of the primary charge and you have added the product more than once in the cart, the price of the secondary charge type was calculated incorrectly. The price of the secondary charge type was calculated after applying adjustments on the primary charge type.</p> <p>This issue is now resolved. You must restrict the related pricing context as per your product type to achieve the scenario mentioned above.</p>	CPQ-11802
209733	<p>For a Quote/Proposal which requires approvals and has Cart Locking for Concurrent Access and Run Misc Finalization Task In Async Mode set to <i>true</i>, the Quote/Proposal was stuck in the finalization state.</p> <p>This issue is now resolved. A Quote/Proposal with the above custom settings enabled in the org does not show any error on finalization on the cart.</p>	CPQ-12115

The following issues have been resolved from the previous release.

Apttus Internal ID	Description
CPQ-12010	With Related Price Scope set as <i>Cart</i> , the system does not calculate the correct price for an option whose price is related to another option within the same bundle. For such scenarios, it is recommended that you use Related Price Scope as Bundle and clone the bundle in the cart.
CPQ-12014	With Related Price Scope set as <i>Cart</i> , for a scenario where the price of an option is related to an option product residing under another sub-bundle, the system does not calculate the correct price of option product.

Known Issues

The following table represents known issues on release dated: March 29, 2017.

Apttus Internal ID	Description
ASSETS-784 / ASSETS-772	When you Change or Renew a bundle product, the options are not shown under the correct option group. This behavior is observed when option groups are shared across multiple option groups.
ASSETS-938	The Delta Price and Quantity for an amended asset is incorrect. Delta Price and Delta Quantity is not supported in the previous and current release.
ASSETS-1016	When performing a Swap operation on assets with one-time charge type, the Start Date of the upgraded asset is taken from the Proposal Start Date rather than the Swap Effective Date . To avoid this, you can choose to keep the Start and End Dates on the proposal <i>blank</i> and then swap the assets.
ASSETS-1080	When you click Change for an asset on the Installed Product page and remove an option, the net price of an asset is doubled and the Delta Price is positive.
ASSETS-1165	When a renewal opportunity is created with a one-time charge as the primary line, End Date and Valid Until date does not change.
ASSETS-1173	Cancelling Ramp lines and accepting Order displays positive delta pricing; whereas it should be negative.
ASSETS-1217	Deselection of an option with a roll up (no bundle level Price List Item for the corresponding charge type) does not cancel the underlying roll up asset.

ASSETS-1226	The warning message <i>Carousel Default Icon"!Error: No content domain found. Cannot display icon images</i> hinders the completion of Terminate and Renew actions. You must provide a value for the Carousel Default Icon (Config Settings > Catalog Page Settings) for most ABO actions to work.
ASSETS-1276	Ramp Renew single line fetches the default attribute values along with other stored values on re-configuring renewal quote.
ASSETS-1283	Cancelled recurring lines show both net price and delta price as negative.
ASSETS-1298	Cancellation of the asset does not update the pre-generated renewal quote or cart associated with the asset. Swapping of the asset does not update the pre-generated renewal quote or cart associated with the asset
ASSETS-1319	Cancelling an asset with the cancellation date as start date calculates an incorrect net price.
ASSETS-1321	The Default Asset Pricing Indicator is unchecked. When you have assets with attributes and asset pricing with some criteria, the Is Asset Pricing is checked. It should be unchecked.
ASSETS-1323	Ramp cancellation is not working for Option assets. When a user tries to delete one of the ramps on a ramp option (using the trash icon on the ramp pop up), no canceled line is generated and no delta price is computed.
CPQ-5840	When you unlock the default quantity for a Product Option, Apttus CPQ continues to use the default quantity value derived from the numeric expression you defined. This, in turn, affects the Product Quantity and the Price.

Apttus Internal ID	Description
CPQ-6562	In the community org for classic UI, the system does not show values for the Search Filters on the catalog page. Under Refine Your Search section, you can see all the search filters without their values to select.
CPQ-6586	<p>When you specify "Date Time" value for the product attribute and click Go To Pricing, the system shows the following error on the Cart page:</p> <p><i>!Unexpected type for Apttus_Config2. RemoteCPQController.performAction(Apttus_Config2.RemoteCPQ.CartRequestDO).</i></p> <p>Note: "Date time" attribute type is not supported in this release.</p>
CPQ-7187	The Constraint Rule triggered while deleting a Line Item displays the validation message twice on the Catalog and Cart pages. This behavior is observed when the validation message is triggered from an <i>addError</i> method in the trigger for Line Item object.
CPQ-7642	In a scenario with a constraint rule of sub-bundle to sub-bundle inclusion with Action Intent = Prompt , the system displays the prompt window multiple times and does not add the sub-bundle product.
CPQ-8674	When you apply adjustments to the Line Items in the Summary section and not click Reprice on the Cart, the system allows you to finalize the Cart without giving any error.
CPQ-9433	If the character limit for the name of the Quote/Proposal document generated using Proposal Document Generation exceeds 80, the system throws an error while merging this document with additional documents.
CPQ-10044	For a sub-bundle product, when Show Tab is set to <i>False</i> and option group has Is Picklist set to <i>True</i> , the Product Options tab displays the product attributes on the configuration page.

CPQ-10286	If you have added <i>Apttus_Config2__Version__c</i> field in the Config System Properties > Revalidation Product Columns , the system throws a <i>"duplicate error"</i> on the revalidation pop-up on the cart page.
CPQ-10518	While creating a Price Ruleset, Application Method field is enabled by default, irrespective of value in Application Level field.
CPQ-10659	When you upgrade to this release, intermittently you may get the following error message: <i>Field \$Label.Choose does not exist. Check spelling. RemoteCPQ: Field \$Label.Choose does not exist. Check spelling.</i>
CPQ-10670	PAV extension attribute fields which are marked as primary attributes do not get merged from the child to parent cart in the quote collaboration process.
CPQ-11866	The enhanced smart search displays filter values in the slider which are applicable for inactive products also. Ideally, the system must not consider the inactive products.
CPQ-12011	With Related Price Scope set as <i>Cart</i> , for a scenario where the price of bundle A is related to the price of bundle B, when you remove bundle B, the price of bundle A does not revert back to the original price.
