CAS-0339 6-F9S4W7	<p>When you changed the value of a Product Attribute field after selecting an option on the Product Configuration page, the dependent Product Attribute picklist did not populate the values accordingly. The dependent Product Attribute picklist continued to display the values populated for the previous Product Attribute value.</p> <p>This issue is now resolved. When you change the value of the Product Attribute field, the depended Product Attribute picklist is populated accordingly.</p>	CPQ-347 97
N/A	<p>If a product had attributes defined in the Product Attribute Value Ext object, Field Expression did not work. When you added such a product to your cart, your cart stopped working.</p> <p>This issue is now resolved. The Field expressions are working as expected.</p>	CPQ-349 68
CAS-0438 8-W8S8R6	<p>When you selected All Product on the Catalog page and searched for any product, the Catalog page did not display Filter Results and Refine your Search features.</p> <p>This issue is now resolved. CAS-0418 6-Z4T1Q4	<p>When you selected a value of a Product Attribute field on the Product Configuration page, Apttus CPQ did not populate the look-up field of the dependent Product Attribute. The look-up field of the depended Product Attribute is populated accordingly.</p>	CPQ-345 85/ CPQ-350 27
N/A	<p>With adjustment spread turned on, the mass update was not getting applied on non-adjustment fields (such as quantity). This issue was observed where a group adjustment flag was set to false.</p> <p>This issue is now resolved. Apttus CPQ now applies mass update action on non-adjustment fields (such as quantity) to all the line items where the group adjustment flag is set to false and adjustment spread is turned on.</p>	CPQ-351 79

CAS-0488 9-R4V2F6	<p>When you reconfigured a saved cart after you selected product attribute values on the product attribute page, the value of the dependent Product Attribute field was not retained. This issue occurred when you selected a value which was not populated in the look-up field of the dependent Product Attribute.</p> <p>This issue is now resolved. The lookup product attribute fields values are retained when you select values in the dependent product attribute lookup.</p>	CPQ-351 86
N/A	<p>When you executed Update Product Constraint View in Constraint Rule Maintenance batch job, Apttus CPQ displayed an error.</p> <p>This issue is now resolved. Apttus CPQ does not display error when you execute the Constraint Rule Maintenance batch job.</p>	CPQ-354 44
N/A	<p>When you had a quote that was associated with multiple contract numbers and you configured products on the cart page, Apttus CPQ did not calculate prices correctly. This happened because price lists were not selected according to the contract numbers you provided.</p> <p>This issue is now resolved. The prices are calculated according to the contract numbers.</p>	CPQ-355 59
N/A	<p>When you configured a bundle with a large number of options, Apttus CPQ took too long to respond.</p> <p>This issue is now resolved.</p>	CPQ-355 80

Known Issues

The following table lists known issues in this release.

Apttus Internal ID	Description
ASSETS-1 636	After you have renewed an asset with a one-time primary line and if you perform Change: Config action, an incorrect Delta Price and Net Price is calculated on the cart.
ASSETS-1 641	During Terminate action, Apttus CPQ retains originally discounted price for an option product, although the option price got changed on Change action.
ASSETS-1 647	Renewal Quote should drop lines post Change: Config instead of updating on existing Renewal quote as "Changed Config" asset is no longer eligible for further Renew.
ASSETS-1 724	Config asset pricing criteria are not functioning when single ramp renewed line (renew one ramp = true).
ASSETS-1 769	Asset Pricing does not work properly for Asset without attributes when asset pricing criteria have some attribute API defined for other assets.
CPQ-7272	Apttus CPQ inadvertently allows you to apply the same coupon code for more than one time in order to give incentives.
CPQ-1182 9	If the option group is single-select and requires the selection (min:1, max:1), then you cannot make it optional from the configuration page. You can notice the same behavior when the option is required by default.
CPQ-1233 6	Rollup data get auto-generated when incentives are saved for the first time. You can make additional changes directly on the roll-up record. These subsequent changes should not be overwritten when the incentives are saved again.
CPQ-1373 0	Promotion is getting applied even for inactive coupons.
CPQ-1517 0	When you add ramp with a price escalator, the added price ramp lines take up the base price of previous ramp line rather than latest one.
CPQ-1536 4	When you remove multiple records for Related Price Line Item (To) related list on a PLI, the corresponding entries are not removed from Custom Settings > Config Related Pricing Group Fields .

Apttus Internal ID	Description
CPQ-15521	When you use the CSR flow with Asset Manager button in an account record to view the Installed Products page, the service catalog is displaying zero products under the Relate tab.
CPQ-33607	If you manually select mandatory options after deselecting them, Apttus CPQ displays an optional checkbox. Ideally, Apttus CPQ hides optional checkboxes for mandatory options.
CPQ-33710	With Allow Manual Adjustment set to False, Apttus CPQ did not allow you to apply adjustment through "multiple adjustment" pop-up.
CPQ-34041	All the cart columns are not properly visible on the cart grid when you use Internet Explorer 11. Note that IE 11 is not supported in this release.
CPQ-34534	The Submit for Approval button is not displayed after the Add to Cart action button.
CPQ-34562	If you set the config system property Enable Base Price Adjustment to True, Net Adjustment % gets impacted by automated price adjustments applied by Price Rule Sets.
CPQ-34774	Deal guidance pop-up does not open when the cart is opened in grouped mode.
CPQ-34896	Apttus CPQ removes the auto-included products when you set fieldset criteria during product configuration.

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
