Ability to Round the Price in Each Price Calculation Step

In this release, CPQ rounds the price in each price calculation step considering the precision defined for each currency, both on the UI and in backend calculations. The amount in price calculation steps (for list price, base price, adjusted price, and net price only after each step such as price matrix, price ruleset, line level manual adjustment, group adjustment) is calculated considering the precision of the currency. CPQ introduces a config system property **Enable Custom Rounding** to enable this feature.

Ability to Round the Selling Term

In this release, CPQ enables the Pricing Administrator to specify that the rounded selling term to be used for price calculations, both on the UI and in backend calculations. CPQ introduces a config system property **Enable Custom Rounding** to enable this feature.

Enhancements

The following section describes existing feature that is changed in this release.

Ability to Display Net Price of Current Year Asset on Termination Window

In this release, CPQ displays the net price of the current year asset (renewed asset), instead of the complete life of the asset, on the Termination window.

CAS-12481-C6F6S5	CPQ-37348	UI issue: In CPQ Admin Console, category names were not displayed in same line as the Expand or Compress arrow.

The following table lists the known issues resolved from the previous release.

Apttus Internal ID	Description
CPQ-37271	When you added an asset using the Add/Remove button on the related line item pop-up after using Service Split, Apttus CPQ divided Weightage Amount equally when Weightage type was <i>Percentage</i> .
CPQ-37455	Apttus CPQ did not display products in Service Catalog when you defined Search Filter CPQ .

Known Issues

The following table provides the cumulative list of known issues up to this release.

Apttus Internal ID	Issue
ASSETS-2722 /ASSETS-2724	<p>When Asset Pricing Indicator is disabled, the default quantity is not retained on the service cart from the price list item for any Asset Based Ordering operations. However, Base is retained on the service cart for Change and Renew operations.</p> <p>This functionality is not supported.</p>
ASSETS-2574	<p>Values are not proper for flat price incremented and merged lines on the user interface popup for the Projected Asset Value API.</p>
ASSETS-1769	<p>Asset Pricing does not work properly for Asset without attributes when asset pricing criteria have some attribute API defined for other assets.</p>
ASSETS-1724	<p>Config asset pricing criteria are not functioning on a single ramp renewed line (renew one ramp = true).</p>
ASSETS-1636	<p>After you have renewed an asset with a one-time primary line when you perform Change: Config action, an incorrect Delta Price and Net Price are calculated on the cart.</p>
CPQ-11829	<p>If the option group is single-select and requires the selection (min:1, max:1), you cannot make it optional from the configuration page but can make it optional from the cart. You can notice the same behavior when options required by default.</p>
CPQ-15170	<p>When you add ramp with a price escalator, the added price ramp lines get the base price of previous ramp line rather than the latest one.</p>
CPQ-33607	<p>If you manually select mandatory options after deselecting them, Apttus CPQ displays an optional checkbox. Ideally, Apttus CPQ hides optional checkboxes for mandatory options.</p>
CPQ-35115	<p>When you search for a product in the cart grid that has more than 1 page, the cart does not display any result when the product is not on the same page. However, cart displays the search result when you navigate to the page where the product is listed.</p>
CPQ-35405	<p>When the Smart Search setting is active in the Config Setting, the catalog page does not display the Refine Your Search filter for Search Category Defaults Top Categories, All Categories, and All Products.</p>
CPQ-35448	<p>In an Inclusion Prompt Constraint Rule, if the field Match in Assets is selected for the asset (bundle) in the Constraint Rule Action, when you add a Constraint Rule Condition bundle to the cart, ideally the cart does not display inclusion prompt and the wrench icon beside the condition bundle. But, the wrench icon is displayed and because of this, you cannot finalize the cart.</p>
CPQ-36216	<p>Reset action in the Mass update pop-up in Config and Pricing cart is not functional when applied on date fields.</p>

Apttus Internal ID	Issue
CPQ-36242	On the Cart Grid, Apttus CPQ does not display line items completely. This happens when you only have one line item in the cart and Enable Contextual Totals is selected in Config System Properties.
CPQ-36279	Drag and Drop actions on the line items are not functional in Config and Pricing Cart.
CPQ-36621	When you remove a price list associated to the catalog in CPQ Admin, Apttus CPQ displays an error.
CPQ-36655	On the Service Cart page, Apttus CPQ does not calculate correct Weightage Amount when Weightage type is <i>Percentage</i> .
CPQ-37111	After you add assets using Add/Remove at all levels button and the Weightage Type is <i>Percentage</i> , Apttus CPQ does not calculate Weightage Amount on the related line item pop-up.
CPQ-37247	When you renew service and add new equipment, Apttus CPQ displays 0 as Weightage Amount on the related line item pop-up.
CPQ-37249	In CPQ Admin, when you add a new field in Product Field Weightage in Smart Search Setting , Apttus CPQ selects the Typeahead checkbox by default if the checkbox is selected for any of the existing field.
CPQ-37251	Unit Of Measure conversion is not working for Price Ramps.
CPQ-37257	In the Service CPQ flow, when you reconfigure a finalized service cart, Apttus CPQ does not display the info message regarding service products auto-included via an inclusion constraint rule.
CPQ-37233	Apttus CPQ does not disable the products that are already associated with the category from the all products list on the Associated Product section in Catalog.
CPQ-37454	<p>When you add an asset using Add/Remove button on the related line item pop-up after using Service Split, you face the following issues.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Apttus CPQ displays an incorrect quantity of the service bundle on the Service Cart page is displayed. • Related line item pop-up is blank for the cloned service line.
CPQ-37289	In Service CPQ flow, Apttus CPQ does not support multiple matrices for a price list item.
CPQ-37320	When you define <i>Nova</i> as Cart Theme and you add a product to the cart, Apttus CPQ disables all the buttons except Abandon in the action menu on the Catalog page.
CPQ-37373	In Cart Grid, when Allow User Override is disabled promotions are not displayed in apply promotion pop-up.

Apttus Internal ID	Issue
CPQ-37445	Apttus CPQ does not update the price of an option when the price is based on an attribute value until you select another option.

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
