Resolved Issues

The following table represents the issues resolved in this release.

Case Number	Apttus Internal ID	Description
CAS-02981-M0T1R6	CPQ-34882	When you searched for a product on the Catalog page, Apttus CPQ did not display the relevant search result at the top. This happened when you defined Smart Search.
CAS-08896-R6T9H3	CPQ-36540	When you used a product attribute value field in both Attribute Value Matrix and as a target attribute in Product Attribute Rules with condition criteria, Configuration page stopped working.
N/A	CPQ-36785	When you added a service bundle using the Add/Remove At All Level on the related line item pop-up, Apttus CPQ did not calculate the Weighted Net Price if Weightage Type was Percentage.
CAS-10575-X4R8J9	CPQ-36905	Apttus CPQ did not execute or display the bundle maintenance batch job in the Apex Flex Queue. This happened when you added more than 5 batch jobs to the queue
CAS-12235-C5Q5C4	CPQ-37207	When you added an option product to the cart as both a standalone product and an option in a bundle and then finalized the cart, Apttus CPQ disabled all the buttons in the action menu on the Cart page if you reconfigured the cart.
N/A	CPQ-37214	When you modified a product and then reconfigured a finalized cart and clicked Revalidate on the Cart page, Apttus CPQ displayed an error and did not allow you to finalize the cart. This happened when you modified a product that triggers an inclusion constraint rule with prompt.
N/A	CPQ-37262	In Service CPQ flow, Apttus CPQ did not calculate the price of the options auto-included via an inclusion constraint rule until you added another option.
CAS-12499-J5Y0B0	CPQ-37395	When you clicked Generate to create a proposal document, the Preview section did not load the generated document when the Enable File field in Proposal System Properties is selected.
CAS-05136-W6Z0K6	CPQ-37465	When you defined multiple Product Attribute Rules with Action Type as <i>Allow</i> and the condition criteria for one of the rules was triggered, Apttus CPQ did not display all eligible attribute values in the picklist on the Configuration page. This happened because Apttus CPQ did not consider the other rules while displaying attribute values in the picklist.

Known Issues

The following table provides the cumulative list of known issues up to this release:

Apttus Internal ID	Description
ASSETS-1636	After you have renewed an asset with a one-time primary line, when you perform the Change: Config action, incorrect Delta Price and Net Price are calculated on the cart.
ASSETS-1724	Config asset pricing criteria do not work when Renew One Ramp is selected.
ASSETS-1769	Asset Pricing does not work properly for Assets without attributes when the asset pricing criteria have an attribute API defined for other assets.
CPQ-11829	If the option group is single-select and requires the selection (min:1, max:1), then you cannot make it optional from the configuration page but can make it optional from the cart. You can notice the same behavior when options required by default.
CPQ-33607	If you manually select mandatory options after deselecting them, Apttus CPQ displays an optional checkbox. Ideally, Apttus CPQ hides optional checkboxes for mandatory options.
CPQ-34889	When all the options of an option group are hidden with exclusion rule, the option group remains visible until you click Validate .
CPQ-35035	In the Cart Grid, when any line item is marked as Is Read Only , the cart page disables the Select all checkbox.
CPQ-35115	When you search for a product in the cart grid that has more than 1 page, the cart does not display any result when the product is not on the same page. However, cart displays the search result when you navigate to the page where the product is listed.
CPQ-35401	When you click Generate to create a proposal document, the Preview section does not load the generated document when Enable File field in Proposal System Properties is selected.
CPQ-35405	When the Smart Search setting is active in the Config Setting, the catalog page does not display Refine Your Search filter for Search Category Defaults Top Categories, All Categories, and All Products .
CPQ-35448	In an Inclusion Prompt Constraint Rule, if the field Match in Assets is selected for the asset (bundle) in the Constraint Rule Action then, when you add a Constraint Rule Condition bundle to the cart, idly the cart does not display inclusion prompt and the wrench icon beside the condition bundle. But, the wrench icon is displayed and because of this, you cannot finalize the cart.

Apttus Internal ID	Description
CPQ-36655	On the Service Cart page, Apttus CPQ does not calculate correct Weightage Net Price when Weightage type is <i>Percentage</i> .
CPQ-36693	Apttus CPQ displays extra space in a custom field name when you use consecutive upper case character in the name. Workaround: This is a limitation for Cart Grid user interface. Do not use consecutive upper case character in the names to avoid the extra space between the letters.
CPQ-36873	On the Service Cart page, Service Base Price column is not populated. This happens when you add a service bundle to the cart directly from the catalog page or you configure the bundle first but do not select any options.
CPQ-37112	When you associate 4 or more assets with different criteria to a service product and split the service product based on split criteria with Pricing Batch Size more than 3, Apttus CPQ did not execute the split action. Workaround: If the Split Criteria for splitting Service Line Items is expected to create 4 or more line items, set the Pricing Batch Size as 1.
CPQ-37646	On the Configuration page in Service CPQ flow, Apttus CPQ does not display related line item icon for options in a service bundle that are added by default or marked required.
