## **Resolved Issues**

| NA                   | CPQ-36993             | In CPQ Admin, when you cloned a bundle from another bundle and added both the bundles to the cart, Apttus CPQ displayed an incorrect price for the options of the cloned bundle. |
| CAS-11595-<br>Q6P3H5 | CPQ-37294             | When you defined a large number of ramp lines for a line item on the cart page and finalized the cart, Apttus CPQ displayed an error.  |

## **Known Issues**

The following table provides the cumulative list of known issues up to this release.

| Apttus Internal<br>ID | Issue   |
|-----------------------|---|
| ASSETS-2574           | Values are not proper for flat price incremented and merged lines on the user interface popup for the Projected Asset Value API.  |
| ASSETS-1769           | Asset Pricing does not work properly for Asset without attributes when asset pricing criteria have some attribute API defined for other assets.   |
| ASSETS-1724           | Config asset pricing criteria are not functioning on a single ramp renewed line (renew one ramp = true).  |
| ASSETS-1636           | After you have renewed an asset with a one-time primary line when you perform <b>Change: Config</b> action, an incorrect Delta Price and Net Price are calculated on the cart.  |
| CPQ-11829             | If the option group is single-select and requires the selection (min:1, max:1), you cannot make it optional from the configuration page but can make it optional from the cart. You can notice the same behavior when options required by default.  |
| CPQ-15170             | When you add ramp with a price escalator, the added price ramp lines get the base price of previous ramp line rather than the latest one.   |
| CPQ-33607             | If you manually select mandatory options after deselecting them, Apttus CPQ displays optional checkbox. Ideally, Apttus CPQ hides optional checkboxes for mandatory options.  |
| CPQ-35115             | When you search for a product in the cart grid that has more than 1 page, the cart does not display any result when the product is not on the same page. However, cart displays the search result when you navigate to the page where the product is listed.  |
| CPQ-35405             | When the Smart Search setting is active in the Config Setting, the catalog page does not display the <b>Refine Your Search</b> filter for Search Category Defaults <b>Top Categories</b> , <b>All Categories</b> , and <b>All Products</b> .  |
| CPQ-35448             | In an Inclusion Prompt Constraint Rule, if the field <b>Match in Assets</b> is selected for the asset (bundle) in the Constraint Rule Action, when you add a Constraint Rule Condition bundle to the cart, ideally the cart does not display inclusion prompt and the wrench icon beside the condition bundle. But, the wrench icon is displayed and because of this, you cannot finalize the cart. |
| CPQ-36242             | On the Cart Grid, Apttus CPQ does not display line items completely. This happens when you only have one line item in the cart and <b>Enable Contextual Totals</b> is selected in Config System Properties.   |
| CPQ-36655             | On the Service Cart page, Apttus CPQ does not calculate correct <b>Weightage Amount</b> when <b>Weightage type</b> is <i>Percentage</i> .   |

| CPQ-37289             | In Service CPQ flow, multiple price matrices are not supported.  |
| CPQ-37924             | When you modify a constraint rule action and reconfigure a saved configuration that uses the constraint rule, Apttus CPQ displays an error when you finalize the cart.   |
| CPQ-37922             | When you remove a product from constraint rule action and add a new product and reconfigure a saved configuration, Apttus CPQ removes the new auto-included product along with the product that was removed because of the modified constraint rule. |

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
