New Field on the Quote for Purchase Identifier

In this release, Apttus CPQ enables users to provide a unique purchase identifier on the quote. This purchase identifier floats from quote to cart line items > proposal line items > order line items > asset line items. This purchase identifier is used to calculate the total quantity that spans multiple streams during the increment scenarios.

User-Level Private Views for Assets Grid

In this release, Apttus CPQ enables users to create user-level private views for Assets Grid. However, CPQ does not support administrators to create and provide permission to asset views.

Ability to Change the Quantity of an Asset

In this release, CPQ enables users to increase the quantity of an asset and manage these incremental licenses independently. Users can sell the incremental quantity at the same price point as the original sale or at a different price point. During the sale of these incremental licenses, users can co-terminate them with the existing licenses.

However, CPQ does not support decreasing the quantity of an asset.

Ability to Calculate the Total Asset Quantity

In this release, CPQ enables users to see the total quantity of an asset spanning multiple streams during the increment scenarios. However, CPQ does not support tiered pricing for increment.

New API to Fetch Projected Asset Value

In this release, Apttus CPQ provides users with a new API to fetch projected asset value on the Cart page. When the API is called, the Project Asset Value window is displayed.

Ability to Control the Creation Public Favorites

In this release, Apttus CPQ enables the administrator to control which user or profile can save a configuration as **Public**. The Administrator can achieve that by hiding the **Scope** field in the Favorite Configuration object for specific profiles or users. By defining field-level security, the Administrator can control the visibility of the **Scope** field. When the **Scope** field is visible, the users can save a configuration record as Public or Private by selecting from the picklist. Otherwise, the configuration record is saved as Private.

Ability to Enable and Disable Quote Collaboration notification

In this release, a dedicated checkbox called **Enable Notification Feed** is added in Config System Properties to enable and disable popup notification. This functionality is only to enable and disable the

Quote Collaboration notification. The checkbox is selected by default; however, when you upgrade Apttus CPQ, ensure that you select the checkbox.

Ability to Split the Related Line Item from Service Line

In this release, you can clone services with some or all related line items based on the split criteria in the Service CPQ flow by using the Split feature when reviewing the related line items in the cart. Click **Split** and select one or more criteria on the related line item popup and click **Split**. Apttus CPQ clones the service line and associates the related line items to the cloned service line based on the split criteria. After splitting, the price is recalculated accordingly.

Ability to Clone a Service Line

This release gives the ability to clone the configured service lines. Select one or more service lines and click the copy icon (). Only the service line and its configuration are cloned. Any associated assets are not cloned. This ensures that you can associate different assets with the service line. This enables you to reuse the service line configuration.

Earlier, on the bundle page, you could only create Option Groups specific to that bundle. Now, you need not navigate back to a different page every time you need to create an option group that can be used by more than one bundle.

This ensures that in the absence of a bucket the adjustment is not automatically applied on the Starting Price of the line item.

You can apply adjustments on the bundle or total such that the net adjustment % on the Bundle or Total is set to the user-requested value.

In this release, CPQ enables you to apply or remove promotions or coupons on the line items individually or on multiple line items together (mass application). Promotions and coupon applications must be mutually exclusive.

Enhancement to Collaboration Request

The enhancements to the Collaboration feature are as follows:

- You can now define access permissions to control which user or profile can use the Collaboration Request feature. You can define **Create**, **Read**, **Edit**, **Delete**, **View All**, and **Modify All** access permissions for a user or profile.

- The visibility of the collaboration icon on the cart page is now in accordance with the access permission defined for that profile.
- Now, only the users with **Edit**, **Delete** or **Modify All** access are available in the User drop-down list on the collaboration popup. The collaborator can only request the users with proper access to collaborate on a configuration.
- The **Finalize** button is disabled on the cart page when the collaboration requests are not closed. This prevents the collaborators from finalizing the quote premature.

In this release, you need not click **Reprice** when an inclusion constraint rule adds or removes a product based on the quote header field from a saved configuration. Also, you only need to click **Validate** once to update the configuration changes that are based on different rules and to recalculate the price.

Enhancements to the User Interface

The Related Line Items modal window is enhanced in this release. You can now resize the window by dragging the right-hand side bottom corner.

N/A	ASSETS-2403	When you created a Renewal Quote, Apttus CPQ did not consider the Currency ISO code, which resulted in incorrect currency in the quote.
CAS-05448-V6D4B8	ASSETS-2518	When you clicked Swap on the Installed Product page, Apttus CPQ displayed an error.
N/A	CPQ-12224	When you applied adjustment on a bundle, Apttus CPQ applied the adjustment on options as well. Apttus CPQ did not allow you to apply an adjustment only on the bundle.
CAS-03180-M9S2N8	CPQ-14975	On the Cart page, when you clicked the tooltip icon () , the message window was misplaced.
N/A	CPQ-33415	Apttus CPQ did not apply the adjustment on the Custom Price Point Source you defined when you created a Promotion. You defined Custom Price Point in the Benefits section.
CAS-00616-W2L7F7	CPQ-33524	On the Catalog page, Apttus CPQ did not display values in the location picklist. The values in the location picklist disappeared when you refreshed the browser page.
N/A	CPQ-33976	Apttus CPQ did not display a warning message on the Configuration page when you selected options from different bundles that violated a validation constraint rule.
N/A	CPQ-34323	Search Filters did not work in Collaboration Feature.
N/A	CPQ-34396	When you used \$Config and \$Options in the same Numeric Expression, Apttus CPQ displayed an error.
R2 - ST00010607/ R2-ST00010076/ D-7460/ D-7337/ D-7353/ D-7862	CPQ-34914/ CPQ-34806	You had to click Reprice multiple times when Apttus CPQ changed the configuration of the products based on the rules you defined.
D-7499	CPQ-34915	You had to click Reprice when you changed a Quote header-level field that violated an inclusion constraint rule after you saved the configuration. You had to click Reprice when you reconfigured the saved configuration.

Case Number	Apttus Internal ID	Description
CAS-02817-N6F5L4	CPQ-34981 / CPQ-35299	On the Cart page, the Adjustment popup was partially displayed when you applied a discount on the last line item in the Cart. You saw a partial Adjustment popup when your cart had more than 20 line items.
N/A	CPQ-35045	Apttus CPQ did not hide the Multiple Adjustment icon (\$) on the Cart page when the Allow Manual Adjustment checkbox was not selected in the Price List Item.
N/A	CPQ-35056	Apttus CPQ did not accommodate expressions longer than 255 characters in Filter Criteria field in Lookup Field Setting. Resolution: You can use the Filter Criteria 2 field in the Lookup Field Setting as an extension of Filter Criteria field to define expression longer the 255 characters. The value in the two fields is concatenated to generate a complete expression.
CAS-04408-T8R6Z3	CPQ-35106	When you clicked the abandon cart icon on the cart page, Apttus CPQ did not delete the child carts associated with collaboration requests.
ER16	CPQ-35174/ CPQ-35175	Apttus CPQ did not consider the access permissions for the Collaboration feature. Hence, Collaboration icon was not disabled for the user without proper permissions.
N/A	CPQ-35233	When you associated a global option group to a bundle, Apttus CPQ added duplicate options in that option group. This happened when you removed that global option group and associated with the bundle again.
ER18	CPQ-35243	Apttus CPQ allowed you to finalize the cart before all collaboration requests are accepted by the Sales rep.
N/A	CPQ-35333	In a scenario where the number of assets related to a service was more than 10, Apttus CPQ displayed an incorrect error message on the Related Line Item popup.
N/A	CPQ-35340	On the Cart page, Apttus CPQ did not calculate Net Price. This happened when the price was calculated based on an attribute that is defined by a Numeric Expression.
N/A	CPQ-35347	On the Related Line Item popup, Apttus CPQ did not calculate Weightage Amount and displayed an error message.
N/A	CPQ-35382	In CPQ Admin, when you cloned a rule in the Rule tab on the bundle page, Apttus CPQ displayed the error ' <i>duplicate value found: APTS_Ext_ID__c duplicates value on record with id: a7K290000008rgk</i> '. This happened because Apttus External ID was also cloned with the rule.

CAS-04413-Z7X7S1	CPQ-35447 / CPQ-35499	When you defined Numeric Expressions in CPQ Admin, Apttus CPQ displayed an error. The error was displayed when you copied and pasted the Numeric Expression from Product Console to CPQ Admin Console or you did not use Aliases in the Numeric Expression.
N/A	CPQ-35523	Apttus CPQ did not allow you to define permissions to control which user or profile can create a Public Favorite .
N/A	CPQ-35609	When you modified a shared option group, Apttus CPQ did not indicate that the action affected all bundles using that shared option group.
N/A	CPQ-35701	When you applied a sales type promotion on a line item, Apttus CPQ did not consider the quantity defined in the line item to calculate the adjustment. The promotion was applied on the line item based on the Extended Price .
N/A	CPQ-35727	When you defined criteria for promotion, the Advanced Search option to search products was not functional.
N/A	CPQ-35716	Apttus CPQ did not display the list of available promotions and applied promotions in the Grid Cart.
N/A	CPQ-35755	Apttus CPQ did not associate a Price List Item with the line item when the product was auto-included through a constraint rule with condition criteria.
N/A	CPQ-35824	When you applied a bucket adjustment on a Bucket that does not exist, Apttus CPQ applied the adjustment on Starting Price instead of the preceding bucket.
CAS-07849-C0D9D6	CPQ-35822	In CPQ Admin and Cart Configuration Consoles, Apttus CPQ did not display images and fonts that were hosted from sources other than Salesforce.
00014790	CPQ-35880	On the Cart page, the Finalize button was not functional or was disabled when an option was added to the cart as a standalone product and an option in a bundle at the same time.
CAS-08041-K3F6M8	CPQ-36098	When a constraint rule disabled a selected option in the option group on the configuration page, Apttus CPQ hid that option group. However, the selected option was not removed from the configuration, which did not allow you to finalize the cart.

CPQ-35203	In the cart grid, the Grand Total line was not visible when Enable Contextual Totals in Config System properties was selected.
CPQ-35202	When you dragged and dropped a line item in the cart after notifying collaborators, the position of Collaboration icon was misplaced.

CPQ-35035	In the Cart Grid, when any line item was marked as Is Read Only , the cart page disabled the Select all checkbox.

Known Issues

Apttus Internal ID	Issue
ASSETS-2574	Values are not proper for flat price incremented and merged lines on the user interface popup for the Projected Asset Value API.
ASSETS-2568	The order is not generated when <i>Quantity</i> or <i>Selling Term</i> is added to the Selected Purchase Identification Criteria in Purchase Identification Criteria.
ASSETS-2507	When you define the Config Asset Pricing Default setting to override a specific line status, Apttus CPQ overrides all line statuses.
ASSETS-1769	Asset Pricing does not work properly for Asset without attributes when asset pricing criteria have some attribute API defined for other assets.
