Cart Grid UI Enhancements

Showing Subtotals and Totals Sections on the Cart

The Cart Grid UI shows the sub totals and totals sections at the bottom of the cart page based on a new custom setting called **Enable Contextual Totals**. You can find this setting under Config System Properties page.



The Custom Setting "Hide Subtotals In Cart" does not work when the custom setting "Enable Contextual Totals" is enabled.

Ordering Favorite Category on the Cart

You can set your favorite category to be displayed first when you have multiple offerings, using a custom setting **Show Favorite as First Category**. You can find this setting under Config Select Products Settings Detail page.

Displaying Revalidation Messages for Cart Grid UI and Angular UI

When a price list item for the bundle or options is revalidated, the system warns you with the message that some items may get changed upon revalidation.

A system displays the following revalidation messages based on the business scenarios.

For example,

- When an optional product is removed from a bundle, the system shows the message:
`"Product Structure for the following product(s) has changed. Do you want to revalidate the product(s)?"`
- When a line item is expired, the system shows the message:
`"The following line items have invalid price list items. During revalidation, some items in the cart may change or be removed."`
- When a version is changed in the quote, the system shows the message:
`"Some items in the cart may have changed. Please revalidate the cart."`

Setting Custom View as Default

You can choose one of your custom views to set as default, which then overrides the administrator view. If you do not set the custom view as "Default", then the administrator view becomes the default. The system retains and displays the custom view next time you log in.

Providing an Indicator for Line Item Approval

If you make updates to a quote/proposal, the system displays an indicator "Approval Required" for the line item on the cart page.

Reordering Primary Lines on the Cart

You can drag and drop the primary line items on the cart using the hand icon that helps you sort the products.

Improved Configuration UI page

- Introducing Hide/Show Option group toggle button to switch to view option and option groups or just the selected options. Only selected options are displayed in the Summary.

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- Supporting extremely large Product Code and Product Description and providing the Show less and Show more button to expand or collapse text.
- An enhanced spacing between Option Group-Child Option Group and Option Group.
- Removing repetition of option group while listing the options.
- Expanded the positioning of extremely long text for Product Code and Product Description.
- Improved functioning of the Expand All/Collapse All buttons.

New Admin UI Enhancements

Managing Favorite Product Configurations

The New Admin UI displays the Favorites Settings under Application Management. The Favorites Settings helps you manage the favorite product related configurations including the default image, the columns in the favorite dialog, and enabling or disabling the favorite settings using the slider. When you disable this setting, the **Save as Favorite** option is not displayed on the cart. For more information on how to configure , see [Application Management Settings](#) in the Admin Guide.

Creating Price Dimensions

You can create Price Dimensions in the New Admin UI so that you can use those Price Dimensions on the Price Rules or Price Matrices.

You can see the saved searches drop down list in an alphabetical order. This helps you quickly access your saved searches.

Under **Category Hierarchy** on the **ASSOCIATED CATEGORY** tab, you can rearrange the categories by dragging and dropping and you can delete them by clicking the **X** Action icon.

For Quote, Product, and Favorites objects, you can define “Object Summary” fields, which are shown when the user clicks on the link on the catalog such as Product Name or Favorites name.

The New Admin UI displays the Lookup Field Settings under Application Management, that lets you manage the name of the record, an object of the lookup field, the field name of the lookup field, columns in the favorite dialog, and filter criteria.

Snap Performance for Constraint Rules

Earlier the performance of constraint rules was limited to bundles, inclusion and exclusion rules. Now, the snap performance of constraint rules is introduced for standalone products and validation rules.

You can observe improved performance for inclusion, exclusion, and validation rules for standalone and bundle products. In addition, support has been provided for multi-conditions in constraint rules.

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Hence, for almost 90% of constraint rules that you use, they would execute under 10 to 15 milliseconds of response time.

Providing Product ID for Product Filter Callback Action Parameters

The callback action parameters now contain a product ID that fetches the bundle options and performs an availability check on the options.

Improved Design of Send Proposal Flow

The system detects the acceptable file type (For instance, .docx, .doc, .pdf) and displays distinct icon for the file format. Also, when you try to merge a file with an unsupported format or the file size is more than 4 MB, the system alerts you with an error message.

Improved Filtering of Email Templates

The proposal Document Generation page supports filtering of email templates based on the folders in which they exist. Hence, when you select an email folder, the corresponding email templates in the folder are made available for selection.

Known Issues

The following table represents known issues on the release dated: 14 August 2017.

ASSETS-784 / ASSETS-772	When you Change or Renew a bundle product, the options are not shown under the correct option group. This behavior is observed when option groups are shared across multiple option groups.
ASSETS-1016	When performing a Swap operation on assets with one-time charge type, the Start Date of the upgraded asset is taken from the Proposal Start Date rather than the Swap Effective Date . To avoid this, you can choose to keep the Start and End Dates on the proposal <i>blank</i> and then swap the assets.
ASSETS-1173	Cancelling Ramp lines and accepting Order displays positive delta pricing; whereas it should be negative.
ASSETS-1217	Deselection of an option with a roll up (no bundle level Price List Item for the corresponding charge type) does not cancel the underlying roll up asset.
ASSETS-1276	Ramp Renew single line fetches the default attribute values along with other stored values on re-configuring renewal quote.
ASSETS-1298	Cancellation of the asset does not update the pre-generated renewal quote or cart associated with the asset. Swapping of the asset does not update the pre-generated renewal quote or cart associated with the asset.
ASSETS-1321	The Default Asset Pricing Indicator is unchecked. When you have assets with attributes and asset pricing with some criteria, the Is Asset Pricing is checked. It should be unchecked.

ASSETS-1323	Ramp cancellation is not working for Option assets. When a user tries to delete one of the ramps on a ramp option (using the trash icon on the ramp pop up), no canceled line is generated and no delta price is computed.
ASSETS-1378	For Auto Ramp feature on the cart, you are unable to add a new ramp line or delete an existing ramp line.
ASSETS-1600	For Change: Configuration action on an option product, an incorrect, negative Net Unit Price is calculated for the canceled option line items.
ASSETS-1601	For Change: Configuration action on a bundle product, an incorrect Net Unit Price is displayed at the bundle roll up line item because of incorrect, negative Net Unit Price on the canceled option line items.
ASSETS-1620	With Default Asset Pricing Indicator set to <i>true</i> and Enable One Time Charge set to <i>false</i> , renewing or changing a bundled asset displays negative Delta Price for the option product.
ASSETS-1643	For Change: Configuration action on a standalone product, incorrect Net Price is calculated for canceled ramp lines on the cart.
CPQ-5840	When you unlock the default quantity for a Product Option, Apttus CPQ continues to use the default quantity value derived from the numeric expression which you defined. This, in turn, affects the Product Quantity and the Price.
CPQ-6562	In the community org for classic UI, the system does not show values for the Search Filters on the catalog page. Under Refine Your Search section, you can see all the search filters without their values to select.
CPQ-6586	When you specify "Date Time" value for the product attribute and click Go To Pricing , the system shows the following error on the Cart page:

CPQ-8674	<p>When you apply adjustments to the Line Items in the Summary section and do not click Reprice on the Cart, the system allows you to finalize the Cart without giving any error.</p>
CPQ-9433	<p>If the character limit for the name of the Quote/Proposal document generated using Proposal Document Generation exceeds 80, the system throws an error while merging this document with other additional documents.</p>
CPQ-10044	<p>For a sub-bundle product, when Show Tab is set to <i>False</i> and option group has Is Picklist set to <i>True</i>, the Product Options tab displays the product attributes on the configuration page.</p>
CPQ-10286	<p>If you have added <i>Apttus_Config2__Version__c</i> field in the Config System Properties > Revalidation Product Columns, the system throws a <i>"duplicate error"</i> on the revalidation pop-up on the cart page.</p>
CPQ-10659	<p>When you upgrade to this release, intermittently you may get the following error message: <i>Field \$Label.Choose does not exist. Check spelling. RemoteCPQ: Field \$Label.Choose does not exist. Check spelling.</i></p>

CPQ-10670	PAV extension attribute fields, which are marked as primary attributes, do not get merged from the child to parent cart in the quote collaboration process.
CPQ-11866	The enhanced smart search displays filter values in the slider, which are applicable for inactive products also. Ideally, the system must not consider the inactive products.
CPQ-12011	With Related Price Scope set as <i>Cart</i> , for a scenario where the price of bundle A is related to the price of bundle B, after removing bundle B, the price of bundle A does not revert to the original price.
CPQ-12074	Currently for Application Management Settings in the Admin Console, there is no provision to read all the flow related actions or columns in one setting group. As an admin, you have to create one setting group for each flow.
CPQ-12097	<p>A system does not update the custom setting record name when you attempt to configure the custom settings.</p> <p>Workaround: Avoid keeping more than one entries in the backend. For example, on config system properties; create only "System Properties" same with other custom setting records for primary settings. Leaving custom setting with just one default expected records works well.</p>
CPQ-12341	<p>New Admin Console: At the following places, unable to use Product Attribute value extension object fields:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rules Tab: Constraint Rule Condition Criteria • Rules Tab: Constraint Rule Action Criteria • Rules Tab: PAR Condition Criteria • Options Tab: Numeric Expression • Attributes Tab: Numeric Expression • PLI Charge Type Criteria pop-up

CPQ-12476	For Proposal Document Generation in the SF1 mobile app, the drag and drop functionality for merging and uploading documents from local storage or Salesforce is not available.
CPQ-12504	In the new Admin Console, the Lookup Field tab available at CPQ Admin > Application Management > Developer tab is not functional with the current release.
CPQ-12647	Getting numeric expression related errors on configuring a product and its values are also not getting set on pick list or multi picklist. When you use an empty string to reset the value, it works fine if set to null.
CPQ-12662	The Option lines on the right panel of the Cart are not visible when a bundle has almost 10 price ramp lines.
CPQ-12679	For Application Management Settings in the Admin Console, in the Cart Page tab, no data is rendered for different columns such as Agreement Price Rule and Tiered Price . Workaround: On the backend, update the setting group display type to column then it starts working.
CPQ-12769	New Admin Console: The Show Rules for Options check box does not read the nested bundle rules.
CPQ-13437	New Admin Console: In Application Management when you do the Mass Update on the cart page, the data and the newly created flows are not getting rendered. Workaround: From the existing Visual Force page, configure display column settings record.

CPQ-13460	New Admin Console: In Application Management > Analyze Deal tab, data is not rendered as per the flow settings in multiple sections.
CPQ-13471	Nova UI: Termination validation message is not visible on Termination Intermediate page.
CPQ-13493	<p>New Admin Console: For a newly installed org, in the Application Management settings, clicking the Load Default button does not render the required data.</p> <p>Workaround: You must save the Display Column Settings and Display Action Settings for the default flow in Salesforce before clicking Load Default in Application Settings.</p>
CPQ-13506	New Admin Console: For a Price Rule, the lookup field in the Condition Criteria pop-up dialog does not show all the relevant fields.
CPQ-13883	<p>Cart Grid UI: When the setting <code>EnableContextualTotals</code> is turned ON, the subtotals lines do not allow you to apply adjustments on the cart.</p> <p>Workaround: Do not include net adjustment column in display column settings .</p>
CPQ-13989	<p>New Admin Console: A system does not follow the mandatory fields list logic from "Apttus_Config2__ProductDetailFields", rather it has started following the logic from ProductDetails Schema definition.</p> <p>Workaround: Keep the product schema definition as mandatory on the field in the New Admin UI.</p>
CPQ-14027	<p>New Admin Console: Lack of field level security on the custom fields, which are created on the object "Apttus_Config2__ProductAttributeValue_c", causes issues. As a result, the system cannot fetch data from those custom fields during extraction of CSV file and the Attribute Value Matrix entries have no content in them.</p> <p>Workaround: Ensure that Salesforce field level security rights are set correctly for all the fields that you are using for the Attribute Value Matrix.</p>
