Resolved Issues

The following table lists issues that are resolved in this release.

N/A	Product images in the catalog page displayed as an URL instead of displaying the actual image. This issue is now resolved. The catalog page now displays actual images instead of the URL.	CPQ-35055
N/A	If the price list item of a product had expired and if a user had created another valid price list item, reconfigured products, and revalidated the cart, then the existing product disappeared instead of considering the valid price list item. This issue is now resolved. Products are displayed during cart revalidation and the PLLs are applied to products correctly.	CPQ-35007

The following issues have been resolved from the previous release.

Apttus Internal ID	Description
CPQ-34290	When a user clicked Multiple Adjustments pop-up, and closed the pop-up window, without making any updates the reprice action became active. Later, if the user clicked Finalize before clicking Reprice , Apttus CPQ displayed a price-pending error. This issue is resolved.
CPQ-34773	Product sequence on the cart was getting changed post-collaboration request merge action. This issue is resolved.
CPQ-34867	The auto-included product is getting removed from the cart when you merge the condition product. This issue is resolved.

Known Issues

The following table lists known issues in this release.

Apttus Internal ID	Description
ASSETS-1636	After you have renewed an asset with a one-time primary line when you perform Change: Config action, an incorrect Delta Price and Net Price is calculated on the cart.
ASSETS-1641	During Terminate action, the system retains originally discounted price for an option product, although the option price got changed on Change action.
ASSETS-1647	Renewal Quote should drop lines post Change: Config instead of updating on existing Renewal quote as "Changed Config" asset is no longer eligible for further Renew.
ASSETS-1724	Config asset pricing criteria are not functioning when single ramp renewed line (renew one ramp = true).
ASSETS-1769	Asset Pricing does not work properly for Asset without attributes when asset pricing criteria have some attribute API defined for other assets.
CPQ-7272	You are able to apply the same coupon for more than once in order to give incentives.
CPQ-11829	If the option group is single-select and requires the selection (min:1, max:1), then you cannot make it optional from the configuration page but can make it optional from the cart. You can notice the same behavior when the option is required by default.
CPQ-12336	Rollup data get auto-generated when incentives are saved for the first time. You can make additional changes directly on the roll-up record. These subsequent changes should not be overwritten when the incentives are saved again.
CPQ-13730	Promotion is getting applied for inactive coupons.
CPQ-14443	If option End Date is less than bundle End Date, on reprice bundle End Date changes and becomes equal to option End Date.
CPQ-15170	When you add ramp with a price escalator, the added price ramp lines take up the base price of previous ramp line rather than latest one.
CPQ-15364	When you remove multiple records for Related Price Line Item (To) related list on a PLI, the corresponding entries are not removed from Custom Settings > Config Related Pricing Group Fields .
CPQ-15521	When you use the CSR flow with Asset Manager button in an account record to view the Installed Products page, the service catalog is displaying zero products under the Relate tab.

CPQ-33607	If you manually select mandatory options after deselecting them, Apttus CPQ displays optional checkbox. Ideally, Apttus CPQ hides optional checkboxes for mandatory options.
CPQ-33710	With Allow Manual Adjustment set to False, Apttus CPQ did not allow you to apply adjustment through "multiple adjustment" pop-up.
CPQ-34041	All the cart columns are not correctly visible on the cart grid when you use Internet Explorer 11. Note that IE 11 is not supported in this release.
CPQ-34534	The Submit for Approval button is not available after the Add to Cart action button if the customer related assets with an offer by using the Add to Cart button on the cart page. However, if the assets are configured instead of adding to cart, then Submit for Approval button is active.
CPQ-34562	If you set the config system property Enable Base Price Adjustment to True, Net Adjustment % gets impacted by automated price adjustments applied by Price Rule Sets.
CPQ-34774	Deal guidance pop-up does not open when the cart is opened in grouped mode.
CPQ-34896	Apttus CPQ removes the auto-included products when you have set a field set criteria during product configuration.

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
