reCAPTCHA Upgraded on Supplier Onboarding Portal

The Supplier Onboarding Portal is now integrated with the latest reCAPTCHA version 2. reCAPTCHA, a free CAPTCHA service, is essential at the time of onboarding to avoid spam and malicious sign-ins.

- i** reCAPTCHA version 1 has been deprecated by Google since March 2018. From Summer 2018 Patch 3 release, Apttus Source to Pay does not support reCAPTCHA version 1. All the customers currently using older versions of Apttus Source to Pay must perform the following steps for the reCAPTCHA to work with Version 2 Public Keys:
1. Upgrade Apttus Source to Pay to Summer 18 Patch 3 release.
 2. Upgrade to and configure reCAPTCHA version 2 in Apttus Source to Pay for the new reCAPTCHA to work with the Supplier Onboarding Portal.

Known Issues

The following table provides the cumulative list of known issues up to this release.

Apttus Internal ID	Issue
SCM-1097	When a user deletes a Supplier(s) from a Master Scorecard and then saves the Scorecard, the Supplier(s) entry is not deleted after saving.
SCM-1046	For a sourcing event which has more than 10 RFQ question, the suppliers (Public suppliers) are unable to respond to more than 10 questions as pagination is not available on RFQ response creation page.
SCM-991	<p>When a user tries to download files that are more than 25 MB (collectively) in size, Download All functionality does not work, and the user cannot download the files collectively. The user has to download them individually.</p> <p>Workaround: User can select the files in such a way that the total of the selected files does not exceed 25 MB. Either user can download them individually, or select the files in such a way that total remains less than 25 MB.</p>
SCM-629	The Advanced Approvals package is not integrated with the Source to Pay package.

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
