Sourcing Event Id Link

You now have an Event ID link on the score card page to take you to the sourcing events page. This makes it easier to switch between the scorecard page for a supplier and the sourcing event page, to review the RFI or RFQ responses. However, if a score card is not mapped to any sourcing event, this field will be hidden.

Adding RFQ questions after Submitting Responses

You can now add questions in the RFQ after the suppliers have submitted their RFQ responses. You can also request responses for the new RFQ questions for the portal suppliers. For the non-portal suppliers, the Buyer can now access the updated RFQ questions and submit the RFQ responses on the supplier's behalf.

Resolved Issues

The following table lists the issues resolved in this release.

Case Number	Apttus Internal ID	Description
N/A	SRM-1146	When you entered the RFI responses on behalf of the non-portal suppliers and the response were longer than 255 characters, you saw an error. This issue is now resolved.

Known Issues

The following table provides the cumulative list of known issues up to this release.

Apttus Internal ID	Issue
SCM-1097	When a user deletes a Supplier(s) from a Master Scorecard and then saves the Scorecard, the Supplier(s) entry is not deleted after saving.
SCM-1046	For a sourcing event which has more than 10 RFQ question, the suppliers (Public suppliers) are unable to respond to more than 10 questions as pagination is not available on RFQ response creation page.
SCM-991	<p>When a user tries to download files that are more than 25 MB (collectively) in size, Download All functionality does not work, and the user cannot download the files collectively. The user has to download them individually.</p> <p>Workaround: User can select the files in such a way that the total of the selected files does not exceed 25 MB. Either user can download them individually, or select the files in such a way that total remains less than 25 MB.</p>
SCM-629	The Advanced Approvals package is not integrated with the Source to Pay package.
