NA	Benefit amount tiers generated only incentive adjustment line items. Due to this, rebate callback never got called and users could not prorate the rebate amount for all benefit amount tiers. This issue is now resolved.	REBATE - 407
NA	As per customer business rules, users used rebate callback to prorate and it was working fine. But when user tried to create rebate callback test class and attempting execution on it, an error occurred due to protected method. This issue is now resolved.	REBATE - 408
NA	UOM conversion was working fine in case of first/single order per program, but in case of multiple orders for the same rebate program for highest tier, UOM conversion was not working. This issue is now resolved.	REBATE - 411
