New Features

The following features are new to Partner Commerce in this release.

SDK Integration with TurboPricing

Partner Commerce introduces TurboPricing integration for pricing calculations to offload complex pricing computation workload from the Salesforce platform to the Conga Flexible Compute Platform. TurboPricing is an optional pricing engine built using microservices to reduce the processing time on the cart.

Product Search and Catalog View Enhancement to Turbo Data API's

The Turbo Data APIs are enhanced to build and consume (front-end or APIs) search and catalog views in your applications, requiring searching, sorting, filtering, paginating, grouping, and aggregation capabilities in Partner Commerce APIs.



To consume the capabilities of this release, you must have TurboPricing Version 2021.5.5.
