New Features

The following features are new to Partner Commerce in this release.

SDK Integration with Partner Commerce for Turbo Data API's

Partner Commerce SDK is integrated for Turbo Data APIs that are part of the TurboPricing component with this release. TurboPricing is an optional pricing engine built using microservices to reduce the processing time on the cart. This release enhances the performance with reduced time in fetching the master data such as product details, categories through Turbo Data API's only. To gain performance benefits, you must configure TurboEngines with Turbo tenant onboarding.

 To consume the capabilities of this release, you must have TurboPricing Version 2021.4.1.

Selecting the sub-category on the Catalog page does not display the products within it. <li data-bbox="662 593 1412 929">2. Also, the Product Option Group name is not displayed on the product details page. This is caused due to the Option Group ID field from the managed package with the API name as <i>Name</i>. Workaround: You must select the Option Group field with the API name <i>Apttus_Config2__OptionGroupId__c</i> for the Product Option Group Name to appear.
LS-6579	With the TurboPricing master data integration, the pricelist is not associated with categories.
DC-5903	TurboPricing integration supports up to 20 line items for the price calculation.
