N/A	DC-2302	Bundle with date attribute was not displayed in E-Commerce. This issue is now resolved.
N/A	DC-2297	While searching a product, using hyphen "-" in the search query displayed an error. This issue is now resolved.
N/A	DC-2293	There was an UI issue on the reference template where after logging in and resetting the password, the Reset Password pane was not closing upon clicking the Close  icon. This issue is now resolved.
N/A	DC-2292	Inactive options in CPQ was displayed on the Product Configuration page in E-Commerce. This issue is now resolved.
N/A	DC-2291	Currency conversion was not working after changing the Country. The currency change happened only upon page refresh. This issue is now resolved.

Known Issues

DC-2571	While configuring a product, error is displayed on View Cart page, but not on the edit configuration page.
DC-2570	Error is still displayed even after resolving the error on the Product details page of bundle.
