Digital Commerce introduces TurboPricing integration for pricing calculations to offload complex pricing computation workload from the Salesforce platform to the Apttus Flexible Compute Platform. TurboPricing is an optional pricing engine built using microservices to reduce the processing time on the cart.

The Digital Commerce SDK is enhanced to make pricing changes. *skipPricing* and *skipRules* flags are made available in the environment file.

Flag	Description
skipPricing	By default, this flag is set to True. Changes to an existing cart skip pricing. Setting this flag to False allows pricing when changes are done to an existing cart.
skipRules	By default, this flag is set to False. Changes to the existing cart evaluate the rules. Setting this flag to True skips rules when changes are done to an existing cart.

You may use these flags to make changes to the cart with or without pricing parameters.

- skipPricing = True and skipRules = False
- skipPricing = False and skipRules = True
- skipPricing = False and skipRules = False
