### Minimum and Maximum Product Validation Support

The minimum and maximum options configuration now works at all levels of option groups. Also, the minimum and maximum product quantity validation now works for level 1 of option groups. The product details page and the Cart details page also show validation errors for the unfulfilled minimum and maximum options configuration. The **Add to Cart** button on product details page and the **Place Order** button on the cart details page are disabled until you resolve all the validation errors.

## Resolved Issues

The following table lists the issues resolved in this release.

Case Number	Apttus Internal ID	Description
N/A	DC-3926	Minimum and maximum product quantity validation was not working on level-1 option group products.
N/A	DC-3762	Users were able to select multiple radio buttons even when the Min/Max was set to 1 on the option group.
N/A	DC-3739	Marking the Attribute Rule to Hidden was not hiding the complete Attribute instead just hid the drop-down value.
N/A	DC-3718	Base template was using boot strap library version 5.1.1 and SDK library used version 4.1.1. Hence, the SDK library was upgraded to version 5.1.1.
N/A	DC-3691	Nested Bundles were not working as expected.
N/A	DC-3644	Product Attribute record was created even when there were no attributes for a Standalone product.
N/A	DC-3637	Attributes for assets were not displayed on the Installed Products page.
N/A	DC-3593	Product Service was returning all Price List Items except the one associated with it.
N/A	DC-3588	While selecting product attributes with multi-select values, even the non-configured values could be selected.
N/A	DC-3584	Country code and State province fields were not displayed on the checkout page.
N/A	DC-3574	Product Service was returning all Price List Items except the one associated with it.
N/A	DC-3500	Manual promotion was not getting applied to the cart even when the <i>Allow User Override</i> flag was set to true in the Incentive Property Settings.
N/A	DC-3383	Buy more option was not functioning for one time asset, as the selected line item was not getting added to the cart.
N/A	DC-3353	Update configuration was not functioning for option products, which were selected from configuration popup.

The following table lists the known issues resolved from the previous release.

DC-3833	After auto promotion was applied and removed, manual promotion was not applied.

<b>Apttus Internal ID</b>	<b>Description</b>
DC-3586	Manual promotion was not automatically removed when you updated the product quantity when the promotion criteria was no longer fulfilled. This happened specifically when there was only one manual promotion applied.
