TurboPricing Integration with Digital Commerce

Digital Commerce introduces TurboPricing integration for pricing calculations to offload complex pricing computation workload from the Salesforce platform to the Apttus Flexible Compute Platform. TurboPricing is an optional pricing engine built using microservices to reduce the processing time on the cart.

Introducing CPQ REST API Version 2

With CPQ REST API Version 2, the following REST APIs are updated to support both TurboPricing and CPQ Pricing.

- [POST] /carts/{cartId}/price
- [POST] /carts/{cartId}/promotions
- [DELETE] /carts/{cartId}/promotions/{couponCode}

OPQ REST API Version 2 supports TurboPricing and CPQ Pricing; whereas CPQ REST API Version 1 only supports CPQ Pricing. Also, the SDK is integrated with Version 1 and not Version 2.
