The following feature is new in this release:

New Agreement Pages with Lightning Design

The Summer 2017 Patch 1 release of Apttus Contract Management introduces a new Lightning design for Agreement pages when the CLM application is in Salesforce Lightning mode. New Agreement pages that are designed in Lightning mode, display an enhanced user interface (UI) with a consistent look and feel across the application to provide a better user experience. The agreement pages that are available with the new Lightning Design are:

- Import Offline Agreement,
- Send for eSignature (For Docu Sign), and
- Send for eSignature (For Adobe Sign)

Resolved Issues

The following table represents the resolved issues in this release:

Case Number	Description	Apttus Internal ID
214054	When a user clicked Clone or Cancel Draft button in Amend Agreement page, multiple agreements were created. This issue has been resolved.	CLM-2711
212119	In Agreement Explorer page, when a user selected View Agreement Hierarchy by Accounts , selected a filter and clicked Go , the search result did not change according to the selected filter. This issue has been resolved.	CLM-2682

The following issues have been resolved from the previous release(s).

Apttus Internal ID	Description
CLM-2317	In agreement wizard, when a user tried to click inside a field on runtime, the mouse cursor lost its focus and forced the user to use tab to go from field to field. This issue has been resolved.
CLM-2301	When entering text into a comments field in Wizard runtime, the field lost focus, forcing the user to click inside the boundary of the comments field a second time to complete the task. This issue has been resolved.
CLM-2300	In the agreement wizard, the red line denoting a field is required in Wizard runtime was exceeding the height of the input boundaries for all Agreement object fields. This issue has been resolved.

Known Issues

The following table represents known issues:

Apttus Internal ID	Issue
CLM-2730	In Salesforce One app, when a user clicks on the Agreement Actions from the Action panel once, the user stays on the same page. To go to the next page, the user has to click twice. This is a Salesforce limitation for embedded Visualforce pages.
CLM-2695	When creating a new agreement in Salesforce Lightning Experience mode, after selecting the record type and account type when the user clicks Next, the user is directly taken to the view only mode of Agreement Record page instead of the Edit Agreement page.
CLM-2690	In Salesforce One app, clicking the lookup option doesn't open a new pop-up window.
CLM-2689	In Salesforce Lightning mode, when creating a new agreement from the Accounts page, the Account field of the agreement record remains blank, instead of showing the name of the Account from which the agreement is being created.
CLM-2440	After an agreement document is sent for review, the activity history does not record details for any of the attachments.
CLM-2416	Entries on the Master Agreement Clauses listing are showing an incorrect time stamp.
CLM-2319	When a user uses the type ahead search feature in the Wizard Component Library, text is sometimes deleted as it is being typed.
