Enhancement to Document Versioning

This release introduces the following enhancements to the Document Versioning feature for Contract Management and X-Author for Contracts:

- Introduction of a new Document Version property to configure the starting value for document version number. Using the Initial Version field, you will be able to configure the document version to start from either 0, or 1.
- Update to the existing Comply System Property 'Document Naming Convention' to include a configurable version attribute. This will allow the administrators to configure the version number, to append it to the document naming convention.

Known Issues

The following table represents the known issues:

CLM-2571	In Document Version Properties custom setting page, the following settings are not currently functioning: Document Regenerate, Increment Checkin Final, Increment Checkin With Redlines, Increment Checkin Without Redlines.
CLM-2482	When a user selects an agreement document from the Search by User results while checking out an agreement document in X-Author Contracts, the agreement document fails to check out.
CLM-2440	After an agreement document is sent for review, the activity history does not record details for any of the attachments.
CLM-2249	On adding text in the comments box associated with the Attachments and Comments section, the user gets an error or the Wizard hangs.
CLM-2416	Entries on the Master Agreement Clauses listing are showing an incorrect time stamp.
CLM-2300	The red line denoting a field is required in Wizard runtime is exceeding the height of the input boundaries for all Agreement object fields.
CLM-2301	When entering text into a comments field in Wizard runtime, the field loses focus, forcing the user to click inside the boundary of the comments field a second time to complete the task.

CLM-2317	After entering text into a field, clicking to the next field loses focus, forcing the users to click inside the boundary of the comments field for a second time to complete the task. Current workaround is to use the tab key to move to the next field.
CLM-2319	When a user uses the type ahead search feature in the Wizard Component Library, text is sometimes deleted as it is being typed.
