NA	<p>While creating a billing plan, if you had set <b>Bundle Invoice Level</b> as <i>Bundle</i> for the bundle product and <b>Bundle Invoice Level</b> as <i>Bundle</i> for the option products, the option products were not linked to the Billing Plan.</p> <p>This issue is now resolved. Apttus Billing Management associates the Billing Plan with the bundle product and all the option products that have <b>Bundle Invoice Level</b> as <i>Bundle</i>. This resolution is only supported for Billing Plans with Billing Method as Percentage.</p>	BIL-1698
